Don Bonner advised that his Uncle was a hereditary chief in a band in Ontario. In July, Don participated in a tribal canoe journey from Nanaimo to Puyallup Washington. Don was part of the Snuneymuxw First Nation and each night they would arrive at another tribal band's location on their southern journey, ask for permission to land and then join the local tribal band for food, singing and dancing. At each location there was lots of friendly competitions.



After their stay they would be joined by this tribal band on their continuing journey to Puyallup. Don advised that they had to carry their canoe above the high tide mark each night, this required about fifty people.

Upon arrival at their final destination there were 7000 in attendance. The host tribe provided a feast of salmon, clams and crabs that only took two and a half hours to feed everyone. The festivities then began.
