**Samantha Letourneau** – Literacy Central, guest speaker.

Powerpoint was not able to be hooked up, as we required an adaptor for her Mac.

Thanked our club for all donations and hard work that we do for them, as adults and families with literacy needs are not well funded.

They have 1 to 1 tutoring, 140 volunteers tutors who go through a training program to match them up the right people. Over 28 years, they have trained 900 volunteer tutors, 3000-9000 hours worked. Since 1999, they have given out 2000 refurbished computers.

Sam spoke on the cycle of learning. Refugees are placed in school in a grade that corresponds to their age. So a 15-year-old would be placed in grade 10, although she/he may have very limited education, up to grade 5 because circumstances.

700,000 struggle to read and write in BC alone. We are evolving as literacy (reading/writing) is evolving into financial literacy and health literacy.

Sam adapted well with no power point and presented well.
