President Doug Lum opened his first meeting of the Rotary year with singing of 'O Canada' accompanied by Rod Mont, followed by an invocation.



Our guests this morning were lyla Christie (granddaughter of Graham), Tyler Vaughan of Salvation Botanicals Limited (who has been proposed as a new club member), Daisy Bereska and Jennifer Fowler from the Central Vancouver Island Multi-cultural Society. Jennifer and Daisy would provide a presentation about their work this meeting.

President Doug then presented a banner displaying the theme of this Rotary year; "Rotary Connects the World".

Presentation:

Jennifer Fowler let us know that this year is the 40th anniversary of the Central Vancouver Island Multi-Cultural Society. The Society was started in the 1970's as boat-people began arriving un-announced.



The Society has grown so that it now operates with an annual budget of \$2,000,000. In 2018 the Society provided support to 1,368 clients, primarily with Federal funding.

The Multi-Cultural Society assists people with settlement in our area. This includes both government and private settlement arrangements. The current Federal government has provided a 3-year grant to assist with the settlement of Syrian refugees.

The assistance provided includes housing, school support, language training (with a commitment to teach English) and employment-ready skills training. Housing of new-comers presents difficulties for the Society as there is uncertainty of the specific number of refugees arriving.

"Career Paths" is a fundamental program provided by the Society. The program is designed to achieve Provincial accreditation for skills which people bring with them. This accreditation is more difficult in British Columbia than other Canadian provinces.

There is also a "school readiness" program which involves all family members in preparing for children to attend public schools.

The Society also provides daycare/ child-minding onsite. This allows their clients the opportunity to attend classes. They also offer New Comer Emergency Fund assistance.

Partnerships and community support are integral to the programs of the Multi-Cultural Society. They are currently partnering with Rotary and the Aboriginal Centre to offer a youth conference.
